Police Report PC Ross Andrew reported that 96 crimes were reported over the period since the last report on 25<sup>th</sup> November 2017. These included 24 shoplifting, 30 traffic offences, and 15 from drug searches. There have been some incidents involving stones being thrown from scooters leading to broken windows. There had been break-ins at a shed when a motor bike was stolen and at The Club where youths had stolen a safe.

It was noted that there would be fewer police in attendance at Gala Day due to the imminent funding cutbacks.

GB thanked RA who then left the meeting (at 7:20pm).
